



## **JOHN TEMPLE LANG**

Dr. John Temple Lang is now with the international law firm Cleary Gottlieb Steen & Hamilton LLP in their Brussels Office, and his practice is concentrated primarily on the areas of EC antitrust and competition law.

He was for the five years 1995-2000 Director responsible for telecommunications, media, information technology and electronics in the Competition Directorate General of the European Commission. He was a Director there since 1988, and from 1974 to 1988 he was in the Legal Service of the European Commission, dealing primarily with competition law and international trade issues. Before that he was in private practice in Ireland.

He is an Irish lawyer, and graduated with first class honours of Trinity College, Dublin in 1957, obtaining the LL.D. in 1980. Dr. Temple Lang is now Senior Visiting Research Fellow in the University of Oxford and a Visiting Professor in Trinity College, Dublin. He also holds an honorary doctorate from the University of Lund.

He has published a book on European Community law and more than 250 articles on a wide variety of legal and related subjects, mostly concerned with Community competition law, including a number of papers on antitrust law in the volumes of the Fordham Corporate Law Institute. He has lectured in the USA, Canada and in many European countries.
